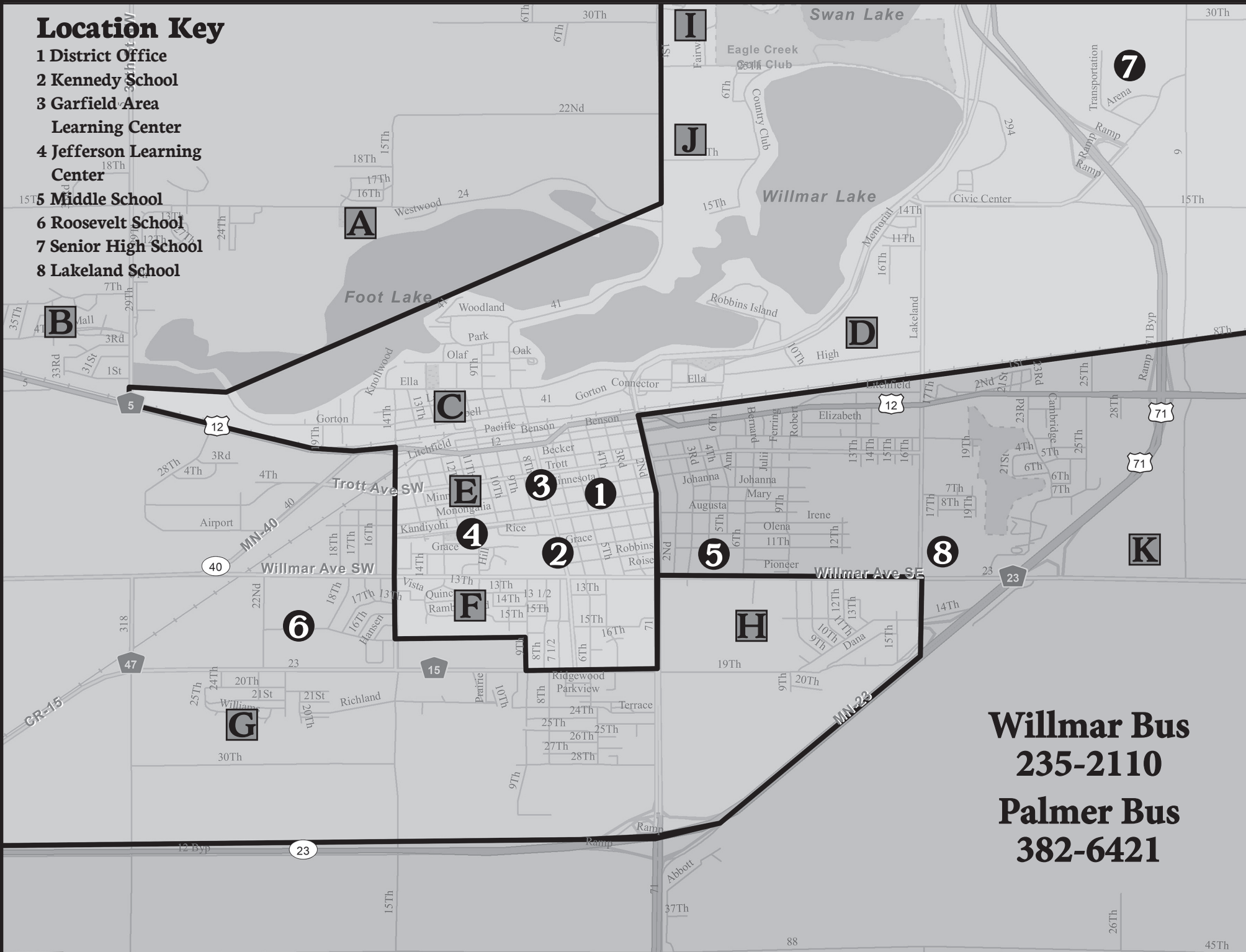
Area K is served by Palmer Bus,

NOTICE: Bus Transportation Schedules May Have Changes

Parents:

Please make sure you and your child know which building your child(ren) will attend this school year. Bus routes are designed to stay within the attendance area of their particular school.

Please look closely at these schedules. Some routes and times may be different from previous years. Please make sure your child(ren) knows the location of their bus stop and their way to and from home.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO PARENTS: We suggest that you and our child pre-plan the way to and from the bus stop together. Discuss with your child(ren), an alternate plan of transportation to school if the school bus is missed. Instruct your child NOT to chase the bus! Stay out of the DANGER ZONE. (10 feet from around the bus)

Students/Riders: Follow These Rules

- 1.) Immediately follow the directions of the driver and/or monitor.
- 2.) Sit in your seat facing forward.
- 3.) Talk quietly and use appropriate language.
- 4.) Keep all parts of your body inside the bus. Windows are not to be lowered below the black safety line indicated in each bus.
- 5.) Keep your arms, legs and belongings to yourself.
- 6.) No fighting, harassment, intimidation or horseplay.
- 7.) Do not throw any object.
- 8.) No eating, drinking or use of tobacco or drugs.
- 9.) Do not bring any weapon or dangerous objects on the school bus. (Note: State law also prohibits bringing animals on school buses.)
- 10.) Do not damage the school bus.
- 11.) Bus seats are to be shared.
- 12.) No portable tape players or radios played on the bus unless using headphones.
- 13.) No gang related behaviors.

MOTORING PUBLIC

Warning Signals

- In speed zones less than 35 m.p.h., a school bus driver activates the bus's amber warning signals at least 100 feet before stopping. When the amber lights flash, you should prepare to stop your vehicle.
- If the speed limit is higher than 35 m.p.h., the bus driver will give 300 feet of warning.



Yellow Lights, Red Lights and Stop Arm

Yellow lights will start to flash as the school bus is slowing down near their destination. Drivers should slow down and prepare to stop. You MUST stop for a school bus when the red lights are flashing and the stop arm is extended: this means that children are getting on or off the bus. Stop at least 20 feet from the bus and remain stopped until the lights are turned off and stop arm is retracted!
