Access to technology in the Willmar Middle School has been established for educational purposes. The use of the Willmar Middle School's electronic technologies is a valued resource in our community. All electronic technologies MUST be used in support of the educational program of the district. This access MAY be revoked at any time for abusive or inappropriate conduct related to the use of electronic technologies. Failure to comply with the district's discipline policy, Internet Acceptable Use Policy, or the guidelines stated in this document for case and use of the iPad MAY result in the loss of privilege to take the iPad home or use the iPad in general. The iPad is the property of Willmar Public Schools and as a result MAY be seized and contents inspected at any time. The student should have NO expectation of privacy of materials found on an iPad.

School-owned iPads MUST NOT be synced to any other computer. The App Store is disabled on these devices. Willmar Middle School uses Casper software to manage our mobile devices. Students will ONLY have access to apps available in the Self Service App, and may not add any additional apps. Students are not allowed to change account information on their issued iPad. This includes, but is not limited to signing out of the school-issued Apple ID.

Device Protection Plan on back of this document!

Willmar Public Schools Device Protection Plan

Willmar Public Schools recognizes that with the implementation of a 1:1 iPad initiative, there is a need to protect the investment made by both the District and the Student\Parent. Therefore, a protection plan is available to each family. The cost for this protection is \$40 per device per student in grades 7-12 and will be due upon receipt of your child's device.

This annual coverage begins upon receipt of the payment in the current school year and ends at the conclusion of each school year (or the termination date of enrollment). **If the iPad has already been issued, then a visual inspection of the iPad by the tech department will be needed to purchase the protection plan.**

All claims must be reported to the main office or tech department of your child's school

COVERED

The protection plan offers complete coverage for the **first instance** of accidental damage (accidental drop, spill, etc.). All iPad parts are covered, including the iPad battery, internal and external components, glass, LCD screen, external buttons, microphone jack, etc. This includes parts and labor. Additional instances of accidental damage will incur a \$40 deductible.

NOT COVERED

- Intentional damage is not covered. Intentional damage is that which is either observed or willfully have occurred or that which is determined by the type of damage to have been willful in nature.
- Loss and theft of the device is not covered.
- Damage to or loss of brick, cord, or case is not covered.

Protection plan notes:

- Protection plan is non-refundable if student withdraws early.
- If the device protection option is not purchased, the student(s) and their parent(s)/guardian(s) will be responsible to pay for all damages to the issued iPad. A non-protection plan device damage will range from \$75-\$325.
- If student enrolls after January 1st, the protection plan will be \$20.
- Removing the supplied case from the iPad will void this plan.
