Families and Community Members,

Willmar Public Schools Food and Nutrition Services, in partnership through a generous donation from Blue Cross Blue Shield through the Healthy Together Willmar Initiative, will continue to provide meals FREE of charge for all students 18 years of age or younger from June 1 – August 21, 2020. Meals will be provided Monday-Friday.

Food and Nutrition Services will continue to offer two meals to all eligible students by school bus. Students will receive a cold-packed Breakfast and a cold-packed Lunch. Please note that there will be fewer bus stops and we will no longer be able to service the Pennock, Blomkest, and Svea areas due to limited funding. We apologize for this inconvenience. The new routes will have shorter stopping times so please be at your designated stop prior to the scheduled bus arrival time.

For more information regarding your nearest bus stop and the time of meal delivery, check the Willmar Public School District website and/or the Willmar Public Schools Food and Nutrition Facebook page.

If you miss the bus stop, meals will be available for pick up at the front door at Lakeland Elementary or the Willmar Senior High from 11:30am-12:30pm. Due to limited funding and resources, meals are at a first come, first serve basis.

While waiting for your meals, please continue the recommended health practices of social distancing by keeping six feet of space between you and the people next to you. If you are sick, please stay home.
