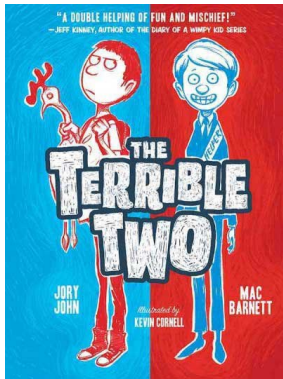

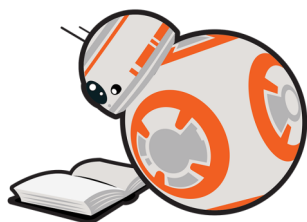
Lego Club
