K-12 Education Credit

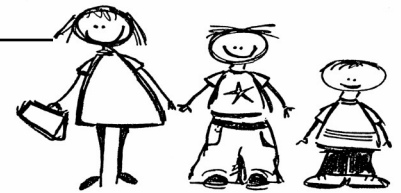

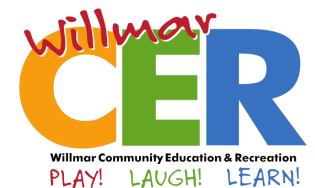
