

K:

Happy May, Kindergarten families! It is hard to believe we are entering our final month of the school year. From the bottom of our hearts, the kindergarten teachers and support staff would like to say thank you for a great year and for allowing us to work with your child each day. We have enjoyed getting to know your child and family tremendously, and will miss spending our days with them! 1st Grade:

Thank you First Grade families for what has been a great year! We can hardly believe we are in our last month of school! This month, we are looking forward to a lot of things - adding and subtracting larger (2 digit!) numbers, digging deeper into place value, determining the central message of a story, and determining key details. We are also excited for our upcoming field trip to the Willmar Fire Station, Police Station, and Robbins Island! More info will be coming about this as the date approaches. We have also practiced and learned many new skills. Students have done a great job keeping a growth mindset, exploring topics such as perimeter and multi-step problems in math! 
