Basically, it takes many people "behind the scenes" and those front and center, our classroom teachers! We are a talented, dedicated group of people who are eager and honored to teach your child. Remember, it is a partnership, so please be involved with your child's day. Friendly reminder to ask about the following to be involved in the school day:

- Ask kids what interests them: "What did you like best today?" "Did you read any new books in the library?" "How did the science experiment work out?
- Ask about specific people and events in your child's life: "Did Mrs. Jones go over that math test?" "Who did you sit next to on the bus?" "Did Mr. Smith call on you today?" "Are you and Jose still having a hard time?"
- Ask what is wrong if your child is in a bad mood: You might find within a few minutes, your child is telling you what (s)he likes. You might ask: "Anybody get on your nerves today?" "Was there anything really hard for you?"
- Ask about schoolwork: You can look over your child's work or the teacher's weekly class note and ask: "Wow,
  what a cool picture of a squirrel. I like the bushy tail. What does he use it for?" "Can you explain photosynthesis to
  me?"
