# Parent Pick-Up and Drop-Off:

- The official School day is 8:30 am- 3:20 pm. Prek classes also start at 8:30 am.
- Students are <u>NOT</u> to arrive at school prior to 8:15 am. The door will be unlocked at 8:15 am for students to enter.
- If you need to drop off your child prior to 8:15 am, please look into Cardinal Place. Call Allie at Cardinal Place 320-231-8490 to ask about signing up for Cardinal Place.
- Parents can arrive for pick-up around 3:10. Parents will not be able to wait inside the school.
   Students will be dismissed at 3:20 pm.
- Kindergarten: See the handout from the teacher; they'll be picked up at the West Parking Lot.
- Grades 1-5 will be exiting out the main front entrance at the end of the day.



Any communication to teachers changing pick-up plans needs to be done by 2:00

### Bus:

Teachers walk students to the bus. Teachers need to observe their students load the bus.
 There is no need for siblings to meet or wait for each other; all are to go to the bus with their teacher.

# Safety:

- Outside doors are locked during the school day, and you will be asked to show your ID if you are
  to enter the building or to pick up a student. Examples of some acceptable forms of ID are:
  Driver's License, State ID, Military ID, etc.
- Emergency Practice Drills take place during the school year. We complete 5 Fire Drills, 5 Lockdown Drills, and 1 Tornado Drill.
- Students will go outside for recess unless the air temperature is below 0°, or the wind chill creates a temperature below -10° F. Please make sure your child has appropriate clothing for cold weather, including jackets, hats, mittens, boots, snow pants, and scarves.

Successful Learners, Teamwork, Accepting, Respectful and Safe (STARS): Our students and staff model and demonstrate behavior and choices that are positive, respectful, and safe. We strive to create and reinforce an environment that is conducive to learning and success. We follow certain expectations and rules to ensure all students and staff members can work in a healthy and equitable environment. We ask that you, too, as parents support our STARS choices and reinforce them at home. Examples are: keeping your hands and feet to yourself, walking in the hallways, following the teacher's direction, respecting others and being kind to one another, staying seated in the classroom and asking permission to leave the classroom....etc. Thank you in advance for your support of our school-wide STARS behaviors.

# **Parenting Hints:**

Set a bedtime routine. Make sure electronics are not plugged in in the bedroom. Research has shown it is even beneficial to turn off any screen 1 hour before bedtime. Aim for a minimum of 8 hours of sleep each night.

Give your child adequate time to get ready in the morning. It takes them longer than adults to get ready. If needed, start an incentive chart to help motivate them and cause less arguments and tears.

New school years may cause anxiety. Try to ask your child open-ended questions about their school day. Here are some examples

- What was your favorite part of the day?
- What did you need help with today?
- What made you laugh or smile today?
