Reminders

- School starts at 8:15 am. Children are marked tardy at 8:20 am.
- The ideal time to drop off your child is anytime between 8:10 8:15 am.
- If you need to drop off before 7:55 am, you will need to look into "Cardinal Place". There is not supervision for your child before 7:55 am unless they attend Cardinal Place. - If you have a child using the crosswalk, crossing guards are there to portal the crossing between 7:55 8:15 am and 3:00 3:20 pm. Please do not let your children use the crosswalk before that time. 19th Ave. is too dangerous to cross without a crossing guard present.
- At dismissal time, kinder students that are parent pick up can be received in the gym.
- At dismissal time, $1^{st} 5^{th}$ grade students that are parent pick up can meet you at your car in the drive through lanes or you are welcome to come in and wait for your child to come to you in the front entry way. We do not allow parents to go down to the classrooms as dismissal time is approaching. The hallways become too crowded and it is a distraction to the teachers as they are trying to wrap up the day.
- Registration fee of \$10 for each student is used to pay for planners, classroom instructional magazines, and help offset the costs of field trips. Please pay the office ASAP if you haven't already done so.
- <u>Vision and hearing</u> screening is done each fall for students in grades K, 1, 3 and 5. We also try to screen all new students and students requested to be screened by teachers or parents. The screening will be done on September 24, September 26 and October 8. If you do <u>not</u> want your child to participate you must notify the school health office in writing.




